

Occupational Health & Safety Policy Statement

Roadgrip Ltd (The Company) is a specialist sub-contractor providing undertaking the following activities in Airfield, Highway, Retail, Motorsport sectors and to a number of private and public sector Clients in the UK and internationally:

- Line Marking/Airfield markings
- Surface coatings, waterproofing primarily in the retail and car park sectors
- Joint-sealing, saw cutting
- Concrete and asphalt repairs and specialist concrete surface protection systems
- Grooving & Retexturing
- Paint removal using hydro blasting and shot blasting

- Assess the performance of the Supply Chain to ensure ensuring that they comply with our Occupational Health & Safety requirements
- Not compromise safety for any business objective
- Ensure this Occupational Health & Safety Policy Statement is communicated and understood within the Company
- Monitor and undertake regular review of our health & safety performance, updating the OH&S processes as necessary to maintain improvement
- Review and update this Policy Statement annually to ensure its continuing suitability and effectiveness

It may be regarded as committing an act of misconduct, should any person deliberately break the safety rules. This includes putting the risk of injury to either oneself or others, also to risk damage to plant or property.
